

Reggio Activities for Week 11: All Ages

Monday: Making Wings

Materials: large paper or cardboard, paint, glue, feathers, coloring utensils

Procedure: cut out paper or cardboard into whatever size wings you prefer. If cardboard is difficult to cut, ask an adult or leave the cardboard the size or shape that it is! Paint or color and decorate the wings however you like. Tape string on the inside of the wings and then tie around your arms to wear as wings!



Tuesday: Feather Painting

Materials: paper, feathers, paint, paper plate

Procedure: Using the feather as a paintbrush, dip the feather in the paint and begin to create a masterpiece exploring the textures of the feather.



Wednesday: Portrait of a bird painting

Materials: paper, watercolors or any kid friendly paint, paintbrushes, water

Procedure: choose your favorite bird and paint a portrait of it. It can be a backyard bird or an exotic one!

Thursday: Bird Feeder

Materials: peanut butter, seeds or Cheerios, toilet paper roll/pop can/small bottle, plate, string

Procedure: poke a hole in the toilet paper roll and string the yarn through. Cover the tp roll in peanut butter, spreading on with a butter knife. Then roll it into the plate of seeds or Cheerios. Hang outside and watch the birds come flocking!



Friday: Nest Building

Materials: sticks, grass, feathers, shredded paper, glue, paper. Any items in nature or in your craft supplies that could help build a nest for a bird.

Procedure: Birds collect items from around their environment to create their homes. Using your materials, we will pile, weave, and twist our own nest, experiencing the hard work that birds do!
