All American

Monday: Faces Across America

Materials: paper, crayons, yarn, glue

Procedure: using crayons in the color of your eyes, skin, and lips, create a self portrait on paper then use yarn or paper strips to create your hair! As a class, we will be using faces of different skin tones and adding all of our self portraits to a class made Statue of Liberty!



Tuesday: Havasupai Basket Weaving

Materials: paper plate, strips of paper or yarn in different colors, glue stick, scissors

Procedure: cut strips in the paper plate almost to the middle, fold the strips upward so they're standing up, use the paper strips to weave in and out of the paper plate strips, glue the paper strips once they reach the end. You've created a basket!

Wednesday: Hopi Kachina Dolls

Materials: toilet paper or paper towel roll, yarn, markers, small pieces of wood and fabric, glue, feathers

Procedure: using a Kachina that Ms. Jenna will show on zoom and in class, we will create our own Kachina using the above materials. The fabric can be used for clothing, the markers to add color and facial features, the wood pieces to add legs or arms, and the feathers and yarn to embellish the doll.



Thursday: Painting to Music

Materials: paper, paintbrushes, red, white, and blue paint

Procedure: We will listen to American hip hop and country music while we paint, moving the paintbrushes how we feel.
