Monday: Build a Rainforest

Materials: toilet paper rolls, green tissue paper, sticks, yarn, glue, scissors

Procedure: using the toilet paper rolls as the trunks of trees, add tissue paper to the top. Make many trees and place them all close together to create a rainforest.

Tuesday: Carnival Masks

Materials: paper plate, feathers, gems, glue, scissors, hole punch

Procedure: cut the paper plate in half and cut eye holes in the middle. Use the glue to add gems and feathers. Use a hole punch to put one hole in each side of the mask and tie a string through each hole to keep the mask on your head.

Materials: Bring your own materials to make anything you want pertaining to our project/study

Thursday: Blue Morpho Butterfly

Materials: paper, scissors, blue paper or tissue paper, black paint

Procedure: cut up the tissue paper into smaller pieces and glue it all over the white paper. Use the scissors to cut the paper into a butterfly-like shape. Add black paint around the edges of your butterfly to look like the blue morpho butterfly!



Friday: Lego or Block Ancient Buildings

Materials: Lego or blocks to build with, pictures of ancient civilizations in South America

Procedure: looking at the pictures of buildings, create a structure that mimics the pattern of the architecture.
