Monday

Zebra Art

Materials

- Black and white paper
- Black and white crayons
- Black and white oil pastels, etc.
- Scissors
- Glue



Steps

- Experimenting with the contrast of dark and light, create your own zebra art. This can be drawing a zebra form or it can be cutting and gluing zebra stripes on paper

Materials

- Wooden or clay beads
- Elastic string or any string that will fit through the beads. The stiffer the string, the easier it will be for your child to string the beads.

Thursday

African Kabosy

Materials

- Rectangle tissue box
- 4-6 rubber bands
- Paint or markers to decorate the box
- 2 crayons
- Paint stirrer or paper towel roll



Steps

- Decorate the box using whatever materials you choose
- Put the rubber bands around the box to look like a guitar
- Use the crayons to prop up the rubber bands so that they don't lay flat on the box (pencils are being used to do this in the photo)
- Glue on the neck of the kabosy using the paint stirrer or paper towel roll
- Play some music!

Cheetah Art

Materials

- Yellow or tan paper
- Black paint
- Empty toilet paper roll
- Plate



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Steps

- Fold one side of the toilet paper roll in so that it makes an irregular circle
- Put black paint on a plate
- Use the toilet paper roll to dip in the paint and make cheetah spots on your paper
