

36 + Months Week 9 Reggio Lesson Plan

Monday: Draw with glue and salt

- Objective: creative expression, sensory exploration, exploring materials with interest
- Materials: glue, salt, paint color, and ear swab
- Procedures: Draw any shape or picture with glue. Put salt on the glue. Put the ear swab in any color and start to tap on the glue and salt.



Tuesday: Seed Flowers

- Objective: care for environment, sensory exploration, follow multi-step instructions
- Materials: corn seeds, brown or black seeds, pencil, eraser, glue, green colored pencil
- Procedure: Draw a pot, a stem, leaves and flower with the colored pencils/markers/crayons. Begin to glue the corn seeds on the flower. Begin to glue the brown/black seeds where you drew the pot. Glue the corn seeds into the flower. Glue black seeds into the center of the flower.



Wednesday: Fizzy Colors

- Objective: color recognition, cause and effect, language development, fine motor skills
- Materials: 4 small cups, vinegar, backing soda, food color, and tray, pipette/spoon
- Procedures: In each small cup, put some baking soda and a few drops of food coloring. Have the child use the pipette or spoon to gather some vinegar. Encourage the child to dump/squeeze the vinegar in each of the cups to see the chemical reaction and to create a fizzy rainbow.



Thursday: Popcorn tree

- Objective: sensory exploration, fine motor skills
- Materials: popcorn, glue, pencil, eraser, worksheet or paper to draw, and brown color.
- Procedures: Color the tree with the brown color. Glue the popcorn on the branches



Friday- Rain Clouds

Subject: science (learn about water cycle and rain)

Material: paper plate, cotton, glue, yarn, pencil, scissors, blue color pencil, and tape

Procedure: Cut the plate in half. Glue the cotton balls on only one half of the plate.

Draw rain drops on the other half of the plate. Color them with blue color pencil, and cut it.

Cut the yarn into 4 pieces. Tape one end of the yarn on the plate and on the other end tape or glue the drop.
